- 1. - Entries received for these races can only be made and accepted on the condition that the Owner,
 Handler and the Rider of their Horse shall subject themselves in all respects to the Regulations and
 Rules for Point to Point Steeplechases laid down and the decisions made by the Directors of the
 INHSC and the Acting Stewards of this Point to Point Meeting.
- No Horse shall be entered or start for any race at this Point to Point Meeting unless a Hunters
 Certificate has been Registered at the Office of the INHSC and published on the IHRB website.
- 4. No horse that has won a race under any recognised Rules of Racing or Steeplechase Rules in any country (Hunters Steeplechases, Point to Point Steeplechases and Private Sweepstakes excluded) on or after 1st March prior to the start of the current Point to Point season, shall be eligible to be entered or run in a Point to Point Steeplechase.
- 5. No horse shall be eligible to be entered or run in a Maiden Point to Point Steeplechase if it has won a race under any recognised Rules of Racing or Steeplechase Rules in any country.
- 6. An allowance of 5lbs shall apply to Riders who have not ridden more than twenty winners combined, under any recognised Rules of Racing or Steeplechase Rules in any country or in Point to Point Steeplechases. The allowance will take into account details of wins in Point to Point Steeplechases since 1st September 2005, and all wins under any recognised Rules of Racing or Steeplechase Rules in any country. A list of Riders entitled to claim the allowance will be available from the IHRB Officials and the Clerk of the Scales at each Point to Point.
- 7. The course will be marked out two or three days before the meeting, when competitors may walk the course, but no riding over it will be allowed or the Horse and Rider will be disqualified.
- 8. The Entry Fee for each horse for each race must be paid with the entry.
- 9. Riders to leave all red flags on the right, white flags on the left.
- 10. All races to be ridden in colours to be declared at entry. Handlers are responsible for ensuring that riders wear the colours printed on the race card, failure to do so will result in the handler being fined
- 11. All runners and riders must be declared to the Clerk of the Scales at least one hour before the advertised start time of each race.
- 12. Permits to ride must be available at the Scales
- 13. No person other than a Qualified Rider under I.N.H.S. Rules or those specified in Regulation 23 (b) (iii) (b) shall ride in a Point to Point Steeplechase.
- 14. Every Owner shall pay a levy of €10 per race to the Qualified Riders Accident Fund. This amount is included in the Entry Fee.
- 15. Handlers are responsible for ensuring that the horse carries the correct weight.
- 16. No responsibility taken for loss or accident of any kind.
