Master Trainer Application

A Master Trainer is a Licensee who has been approved by the Licensing Committee to educate an apprentice in respect of all aspects of the horse racing industry. A Trainer must be able to demonstrate that they can meet the below criteria to be considered a Master Trainer.

To become a Master Trainer:

- A. <u>A. Pre-requisite</u>
 - 1. Held a Flat Licence to Train for a minimum of 2 years, or sufficient riding experience on the Flat
 - 2. Have a minimum of 3 horses Returned in Training
 - 3. Have at least one horse that have a handicap a rating over 55 *(entry handicap of 47)*
 - 4. Have a minimum of 20 runners in the previous season, or an average of 20 runners per season in the previous 3 years.
